Person Centered Case Management / Community Specialist:

We provide case management/community specialist services through our contract with the Missouri Department of Mental Health. This service is very unique and covers a wide variety of supports for individuals with developmental disabilities and their caregivers. Under this service we are able to provide:

- IEP Coaching- assisting students and their families in getting a more thorough understanding of the IEP process and their rights under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). This service can be used as a proactive support to prepare for upcoming IEP meetings, tracking progress, and collaborative and meaningful communication with the IEP and school. We can also provide advocacy supports during any school meeting or IEP meeting.
- Transition Planning- We support teens/young adults and their families in navigating the transition from ENTITLEMENT based services and supports to ELIGIBILITY based services and supports. This is a very complex transition that consists of multiple government and private entities. We act as a liaison between the student, family, school, and community in order to have the smoothest transition from high school to adulthood. This can include IEP coaching focusing on transition specific goals, benefits planning, assisting with completing applications for SSI, Medicaid, etc.
- Alternatives to Guardianship (long term supports)- If an individual or caregiver decides they would like to pursue a particular alternative to guardianship, such as Supported Decision Making (SDM), Power of Attorney, etc., we are able to support the individual and their circle of support in developing a SDM agreement/plan and assist with facilitating meetings with the team.

Benefits Planning:

This is a Work Incentives based service that allows us to review current benefits or future benefits of an individual who wants to work, or currently has competitive employment. We are able to gather information on current and future benefits and work goals in order to provide a thorough Benefits Review Summary that can educate the individual how their benefits may be affected by their wages. The myth is that individuals are at risk of losing all their benefits if they work, even if it's just a few hours. That is not necessarily true, and our Credentialed Benefits Specialist can assist with providing options when it comes to wages, taking advantage of Social Security Work Incentives, and assisting in setting up ABLE accounts.
