#### In General

### **Guardianship Proceedings**

Analysis of guardianship statutes to protect the civil rights of respondents Analysis of court rules to ensure access to justice for respondents in guardianship proceedings Adequacy of judicial compliance with the requirements of ADA Title II and Section 504 Adequacy of the capacity assessment process by experts in quardianship proceedings Adequacy of the training of judges on the ADA and on alternatives to quardianship Analysis of current policies and practices for appointing counsel for respondents Analysis of the training of attorneys on capacity, the ADA, and alternatives to guardianship Analysis of the training of guardians on the rights of respondents Analysis of the adequacy of monitoring guardians regarding protection of rights Analysis of the adequacy of statutes and procedures for terminating guardianships

Review of model supported decision-making (SDM) agreements developed elsewhere Review of model supported decision-making statutes and programs in other states Review of model guardianship improvement legislation in other states Review of model guardianship legal defense programs in other states Review of the position statements of disability rights organizations and agencies on SDM Review of alternatives to guardianship that are being used in other nations Review of the adequacy of court rules and practices on applying ADA to guardianships

Review of civil rights protections for students who want alternatives to guardianship Review of civil rights protections for medical patients who want alternatives to guardianship Review of Missouri Protection and Advocacy services for victims of guardianship overreach Review of Missouri Commission on Human Rights services for judicial system discrimination Review of the role of DOJ when courts violate the ADA in quardianship proceedings Review of the role of HHS when medical service providers refuse alternatives to guardianship Review of the role of Dept. of Education when schools refuse alternatives to guardianship
